Attendance

Please be aware that if your child is late in the morning this will affect your child's attendance. It is disruptive for the class and unsettling for your child to arrive late. Our gates are opened at 8.30am in the morning before the doors open at 8.40am. Please make every effort to arrive at school on time.

The attendance bands are as follows:

- 100 - 97%** - Excellent attendance
- 97 - 95%** - Expected attendance
- 94 - 90%** - At risk of persistent absence
- 90 - 85%** - Persistently Absent
- 85 - 50%** - High risk persistent absence
- 50 - 0%** - Severely Absent

You will receive communication from school when your child's attendance drops below 95%, and be invited to a meeting to discuss attendance if it continues to drop.
